





#### About our school

Nykøbing Katedralskole (about 820 students) offers senior high school graduation as a *General Upper Secondary School Leaving Certificate Advanced Level* (stx – three years) (for University) or as *General Upper Secondary School Leaving Certificate Advanced Level, The Higher Preparatory Examination* (hf – two years) (for professionsbachelor).

We also are one of the few schools who offer graduation for pupils with diagnosis (hf+) with a special timetable and not two but three years of high school.

We offer different possibilities for advanced classes (Talent-classes), science-competitions, poet-workshops with publication of written texts, Team-Denmark-students with professional sport combined with high school.

Our school has a communal feeling where teachers know the students by name and everybody takes care of everybody.

- being the development-orientated high school, which cultivates each single pupil's potential through clear demands and frames in a community-orientated environment

# Nykøbing Katedralskole: Happy, global, green, clever

Internationalisation, world citizenship, language skills, inclusion and ownership are fixed components of our education: each year pupils focus on the outside world as part of their curriculum (for example innovations-projects and online projects) and in the form of a school trip or exchange to foreign countries. All students work with laptops, which are part of common education.

From June 2021 until June 2022, our school is building a new Sportsarena which will facilitate collaboration and cross curricular learning even more – and include the surroundings as a town hall.

#### **Our hometown**

Nykøbing Falster is a seaside town 1.5 hour from the capital Copenhagen



In our region Lolland-Falster, the world's longest road and rail tunnel is being built by Femern A/S, which will connect Denmark with Germany. This includes green energy.

A new transformer station for the Fehmarnbelt Tunnel will be located in Rødby Havn.

Electric trains through the Fehmarnbelt Tunnel between Denmark and Germany will run on green energy supplied directly from a new transformer station.

The transformer station will also have sufficient capacity for a largescale charging station for electric vehicles near the tunnel. The largescale transformer station will ensure that the 18 km Fehmarnbelt Tunnel has a constant and secure supply of power to run electric train operations, the motorway, ventilation and lighting.
